

Unity through diversity



English - Our writing will be based around the books 'Beegu' by Alexis Deacon. We will be writing descriptions, commands and poems. The final outcome will be a non-fiction report. We will also explore 'Dinosaurs and all that Rubbish' by Michael Foreman. We will write letters, instructions and create a poster. The final outcome will be a pamphlet. Through our writing, we will practice using capital letters and full stops, and think about how to structure our sentences.

Mathematics-

We will be applying our knowledge of addition and subtraction to two digit numbers. We will also be learning about fractions, where we will look at halves and quarters of objects and shapes. We will then move onto measuring length and mass, where pupils will have to compare objects that are longer and shorter, and lighter and heavier.

Science

Our unit is 'Taking care of the Earth'. We will learn about the three types of pollution, and recycling, how humans are destroying the Earth and what we can do to help prevent this. We will also learn about materials that are natural or manufactured, and about logging.

Phonics

We will be reading books for our individual level of reading with a focus on becoming fluent readers. Please practice reading these books at home too so children can show off what they have learnt in school and further practice their reading skills.

PE-

We are learning 'Target Games'. This involves developing both underarm and overarm throwing skills for both accuracy and distance, and selecting the correct throw for the target.

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PSHE- Through our unit 'Healthy Me' we will be learning about making healthy choices, being clean and happy, medicine and road safety.

DT

We will design and make our own sock puppets. We will consider who it is for and what they would like, select the best material to use and think about how to join the materials together.

Music-

We will learn to follow a beat and express our feelings through music. We will use instruments, with different sounds and played in different ways, to the song round and round.

RE

We are studying the religion of Christianity and about Palm Sunday. Our Key question is; 'Why was Jesus welcomed like a king and celebrated by the crowds on Palm Sunday?'

Computing- We will learn how to control robots. We will be programming 'bee bots' to move around grids reaching a desired location. We will then be debugging our algorithms to solve mistakes that have been made.

History- We will be learning about Kings and Queens throughout British History. We will be looking at the promises made in the Magna Carter and the activity's Oliver Cromwell banned during his time as lord protector.
